Year 7

Year seven is the year of the present tense. You will express your thoughts and ideas about yourself, your families and friends, your free time and school effectively using opinions and reasons.

Term 1 Preséntate (Introduce yourself)

- ¿Cómo te llamas? – What are you called?
- ¿Cómo estás? – How are you?
- ¿Cuántos años tienes? – How old are you?
- ¿Con quién vives? – Who do you live with?

Term 2 Lo que me gusta hacer (What I like to do)

- ¿Qué haces con tu móvil? - What do you do with your mobile?
- ¿Qué haces en tu tiempo libre? - What do you do in your free time?
- ¿Cómo son tus amigos? –(What are your friends like?

Term 3 Mi vida en TEMA (My life at TEMA)

- ¿Cuál es tu asignatura preferida? ¿Y por qué? – What is your favourite subject? And why?
- ¿Cómo es tu uniforme? – What is your uniform like?

Year 8

Year eight is the year of the past tense. You will build on your use of opinions, reasons and free time activities to describe your city and what you did last weekend, you will learn practical communication skills for use in a restaurant and link this describing a past trip and giving opinions, the year culminates in describing a holiday bringing together past tense and opinions.

Term 1 Mi ciudad (My city)

- ¿Qué hay en tu ciudad? – What is there in your city?
- ¿Adónde fuiste el fin de semana pasado? – Where did you go last weekend?
- ¿Qué hiciste el fin de semana pasado? – What did you do last weekend?

Term 2 Al restaurante (At the restaurant)

- ¿Qué quieres pedir? – What do you want to order?
- Describe cuando fuiste al restaurante – Describe when you have been to the restaurant
- ¿Qué te gusta comer? – What do you like to eat?

Term 3 Mis vacaciones (My holidays)

- ¿Adónde fuiste de vacaciones? – Where did you go on holiday?
- ¿Qué hiciste durante estas vacaciones? – What did you do on holiday?

Year 9

Year nine is the year of the future tense and bringing all three tenses together. You will build on year eight by talking about healthy living, diet and bad habits. You will consider your role in the world by discussing work and future aspirations, exploring how to pursue a fulfilling career and finally discussing your rights as a young person within a global society.

Term 1 Una vida sana (A healthy lifestyle)

- ¿Cómo te gustaría cambiar tu dieta en el futuro? – How would you like to change your diet in the future?
- ¿Cómo es un día típico? – What is your typical day like?
- ¿Qué comías que no comes ahora? – What did you used to eat that you don't eat now?

Term 2 El trabajo (Work)

- ¿Qué trabajo hace tu madre/padre? (What job does your mother/father do?)
- ¿Por qué es importante aprender idiomas? (Why is it important to learn languages?)
- ¿Te gustaría hacer el bachillerato o formación profesional? (Would you like to do A-levels or an apprenticeship?)

Term 3 Jóvenes en acción (Young people in action)

- ¿Qué derechos tienes? – What rights do you have?
- ¿Qué han hecho los activistas para combatir los problemas en nuestro mundo? – What have activists done to fight problems in our world?

Key stage 4

At GCSE, we follow the Edexcel specification. By year ten you will have a solid foundation of content and vocabulary and a wide understanding of grammatical structures and how to apply them to a range of scenarios. You will become more confident in the four skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing and have equal exposure to all four skills throughout your studies. In year 10 and 11, you will develop a wider bank of knowledge and skills in preparation for GCSE examinations.
