- Weekly Assemblies: Assemblies will feature a strong academic focus each half term, with content tailored to each year group. This will include workshops on effective revision techniques, subject-specific success strategies from departmental experts, and motivational talks on goal setting and academic achievement.
- Technology for Progress: We'll be utilising the powerful Seneca Learning platform, providing students with personalised learning pathways, interactive quizzes, and revision materials aligned with the curriculum.
